First, you have to find a brokerage that handles your tradable; you can choose between a full-service brokerages or a discount brokerage. Full service would mean you would sit down with your broker, whereas discount brokerage would involve trading online without any advice from a professional. Most institutions that offer full service brokerages also have the discount broker option.

Other considerations are what kinds of tools or services do they provide? Do they provide real-time data? Which markets do they give you access to? Do they have account minimums? How fast are their executions? How much are their commissions? What kind of support do they offer?

With the presence of freely available company information online, retail brokerage research is less valuable than it ever has been. Nevertheless, if you're in less intensively studied but highly commercial markets such as futures, a brokerage's ability to provide market statistics, hedging activity reports, and other commercial information may be critical to your trading and investing decisions.

Finally, don't forget the security of your money. Inquire about a brokerage's clearing operations, and if you're in equities, about Securities Investor Protection Corp. (SIPC) coverage.
